# SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

SCE aims to make academic education in the engineering fields accessible to all Israelis regardless of their social or economic background. Most are from middle or lower income bracket families. Their success in the engineering profession will raise their standard of living and contribute to the quality of life in Israel's southern periphery. Almost all SCE students must work part time while studying, and many help to support their family. An SCE scholarship ensures that no student is forced to drop out due to financial constraints.

Tuition is \$2500 a year and SCE seeks ways to subsidize deserving students.

The Dean of Students Office offers donor advised scholarships and screens applicants based on their financial status and academic potential.

## NAMING AND RECOGNITION

Each scholarship fund can be named according to the wishes of the donor, and the name appears in SCE communications and bulletins.

Scholarships are awarded to students at an annual ceremony, in the presence of the donors or their representatives.
